

GENERAL ORGANIZATION OF THE BOOKLET

The booklet is organized in three main levels: **Level 1** for beginners of the English Language, **Level 2** for an intermediate class and **Level 3** for advanced students. Besides, each level has been divided into **three sessions** in which learners will have an approach to the story, plot, characters and they will have the possibility to solve creative activities before the play.

The amount of time to complete each session is between 30 and 50 minutes.

2. Meet the Characters


Aim: Meeting the characters of the play and going over English grammar concepts.

THE PLOT

One day, a visitor named Lukas arrives. He has a shiny tablet he uses to take pictures and study the jungle. But Lukas has a secret—he's working for his boss, who wants to build a giant hotel in the forest. At first, Lukas doesn't understand how much the jungle means to the tribe.

As Lukas spends time with Ayla and the others, he starts to see how beautiful and special the jungle is. He even begins to wonder if his project is the right thing to do. But then, his boss arrives with big machines, ready to cut down the trees.

The tribe, Lukas, and his boss face a big decision: Should they destroy the jungle to build the hotel, or can they find another way?

Lukas, a young researcher, arrives, eager to explore the Amazon for a tourism project. He is carrying a tablet and taking pictures




A panther attacks Lukas, and Ayla protects him, saving his life. Ayla invites Lukas to stay with them at the village.

Characteristic: FUNNY

Kauê is the tribe's trusted servant who often lightens the mood with humor. He's/ She's resourceful and dedicated, always finding ways to help protect the tribe.



LUKAS



Characteristic: IDEALISTIC

Lukas is a young researcher who is always glued to his tablet, capturing photos, writing notes, and sending updates.

THE BOSS



Characteristic: GREEDY

The Boss is Lukas's employer, only interested in profit and ready to destroy the jungle for his project: The Hotel.


